I'm pretty confident this information is available--I just can't find it from here. Ideally were looking for dose-response type information that would indicate (in relative terms) how each parameter is affected when X pounds/gallons etc are added to a water system. Obviously each system will be different based on storage capacity, treatment, water velocity, consumption, etc., but if some laboratory type data exists, we may be able to apply to field conditions if we make some sound assumptions regarding concentrations, residence time, etc. The relationship to basic water quality parameters is important because these can easily be checked by our field personnel using existing equipment. The list of potential agents of concern is wide open, but recent questions have revolved around: Anthrax, Cholera, Plague, Tularemia, Q Fever, Smallpox, Venezuelan Encephalitis, Botulism, Staph Enterotoxin B, and Ricin.
